•	 Young riders are expected to remain in the session from beginning to end, unless they have to leave early. If the rider has to leave early, or is being collected by other than the parent/guardian, the parent/guardian must advise the coach of the details of the arrangement, including who will be collecting the rider. 				
•	Please ensure you and your child/children fully understand and adhere to the Bike Club Rules. Any young riders who persistently misbehave or put others in dan asked to leave the sessions and will not be allowed to attend in future.				
•	• It is the parent's/guardian's responsibility to ensure that his/her child's bike is in a safe condition to ride. All riders must wear a cycling helmet at all times during the coaching sessions.
